Hosts

Stewards

- Be a welcoming face **to the congregation**
- Provide support in directing people to the right place and ensuring access points are free
- Providing advice and support
- Remain vigilant and report incidents supporting
- Some stewards will be asked to support specific activities including erection and monitoring the stalls and a team will be required to collect and help dispose of litter at the end.
- *You will be required to complete an online application form and attend an onsite Safety Briefing at on Sunday 12 June*

Support Team

- Helping with the information desk including a specific role for lost children
- Supporting people using the specified area for those with mobility issues
- Collecting, logging and holding lost Property
- *You will be required to complete an online application form, including confirmation of current DBS held at own church.*

Prayer Team -

- Praying with/for those requesting prayer in a safe manner.
- *Must be a member of own church's Prayer Team and online application, including confirmation of being in own church team.*

Set-Up / Set-Down Team -

- Willing to come early or to stay late and help move things around as directed.

All volunteers must be at least 18 years of age. There may be some roles where older children can accompany and help their parents, but the parent remains the "volunteer" and is responsible for both carrying out the duties required, as well as the safety and security of their child.
